

## Navigating the Library of Congress Website

1. Click on the American Memory link
2. Click on the browse button at the top of the screen
3. You can click on a topic, a time period, a place, a specific type of primary source, OR you can do a keyword search in the search box at the top of the screen.
4. Type your search into the search box .
5. Scroll down to the bottom of the page and click on “Gallery view”.
6. Look through the primary sources and click on ones you are interested in.
7. If you choose a primary source to use, you must site the source.
8. The URL in the address bar is NOT the one you copy.
9. Go up to “view” on the top menu bar
10. Click on “Source”
11. Scroll down to the bottom of the window and copy the http address. This is the URL that will bring you back to this resource.
12. Copy and paste this URL onto a Word document and save to your History Day folder in your H drive.
